

## Summary of main changes to the Academic Regulations 2019/20

The following summary sets down the changes incorporated into the Academic Regulations 2019/20, approved by the University's Academic Board to take effect from September 2019 for both new and current students.

## 1. Integrated Masters

The classification of Integrated Masters awards stated in Section 3.1, Integrated Masters, paragraphs 63-65, has been amended to:

- The award of an Integrated Masters Degree shall be classified on the basis of the classification average, calculated as follows:
- The average at Level 5 will contribute (20% of the classification average, the average at Level 6 will contribute 30%, and the average of the best 120 credits at Level 7 will contribute 50% of the classification average.
- The threshold for each classification band shall be as follows:

69.5% and above First class honours standard Second class honours upper division standard 49.5% - 59.49% Second class honours lower division standard 0% - 49.49% Fail.

If the classification average, as calculated in Regulations 63 and 64, falls no more than 2.5% short of the next highest classification boundary, the distribution of credit achieved at Level 7 will be considered. If the marks for at least half of the credits contributing to the award fall within a higher class than the overall average mark, the classification shall be raised by one class above that indicated by the classification average.
