

Online Module Selection Student Guide

The Online Module Selection system (also known as online programme planning or 'Module Choice') is accessed via your Evision account. You will see the link to the system on the Home Page.

Before you start using the system you should have already decided which modules you wish to take, and checked for timetable clashes.

Module Choice for the Next Academic Year 18th April to 5pm on 29th April 2016

If you are a Full-time Undergraduate student who will be continuing your studies you are required to register your modules for the forthcoming academic year via Online Module Registration. The deadline for this is 5pm on Friday 29th April 2016*.

Modules that are core to your course have already been registered for you and you should make sure that the times of any optional modules you choose do not clash with these. Options available to you are listed on the Course Structure for your programme.

COURSE STRUCTURE & MODULE INFORMATION >

It is important that you consult the Course Structure applicable to your year of entry.

You can drill down to information on particular modules. Before selecting any modules you should ensure that you have any necessary pre-requisites, and make sure that you know the codes for the modules you wish to pick. You can get advice about choosing your modules from your Personal Academic Tutor or from staff in your Student Hub.

If you have the option to take an Extension of Knowledge (EoK) Module this will be recorded as XK0000 and you should let your Student Hub know which particular EoK module you would like to take.

If you wish to take an Open Language Module this will be recorded as OL0000 and you will need to attend a language evaluation session in order to be assessed and registered at the appropriate level. Please consult the [Open Language Programme webpage](#) for further information.

You must register your modules by 29 April; failure to do so may mean that you will not be able to follow your choice of modules. Before starting online module registration please make sure that you are clear about your choices; you can make amendments online before 5pm on Friday 29 April but if you wish to make subsequent changes then you will need to discuss these with your Student Hub. You will be notified of any future time-table changes that necessitate a change to your programme of study and you will be asked to submit a revised programme to your Student Hub.

You should click on the link below to commence the module registration process. Before doing so make sure that you have made a note of your module choices for 2016/17. Remember that as a full-time student you must register 120 credits worth of modules and your programme should normally be balanced with the same volume of credit in each semester. You must not submit a partial programme.

Click on the 'Module Registration' link at the bottom of the instructions screen.

When you first log in to the system, you will have a status of GEN which means that your module selections have been generated. If your course has 'core' (compulsory) modules for your next academic year they will be displayed on the screen.
