

### First Step

If you feel you might have dyslexia or an SpLD, please contact the Disabilities and Dyslexia Service to make an appointment.

You will take the screening test on a computer. It will take around 1 hour.

### Second Step

If the screening outcome is positive, DDS will put you forward to have a full dyslexia diagnostic assessment with an educational psychologist.

DDS will arrange the diagnostic assessment for you. There are several assessors on campus. The assessment will last around 2 hours.

The educational psychologist will produce a report called an Educational Psychologist Report (EPR) which will be sent to the student and DDS.

### Third step

DDS will invite you for an appointment to meet an advisor to explain the EPR. The advisor will guide you through the DSA application. During this appointment, the advisor will also discuss reasonable adjustments for your studies.
