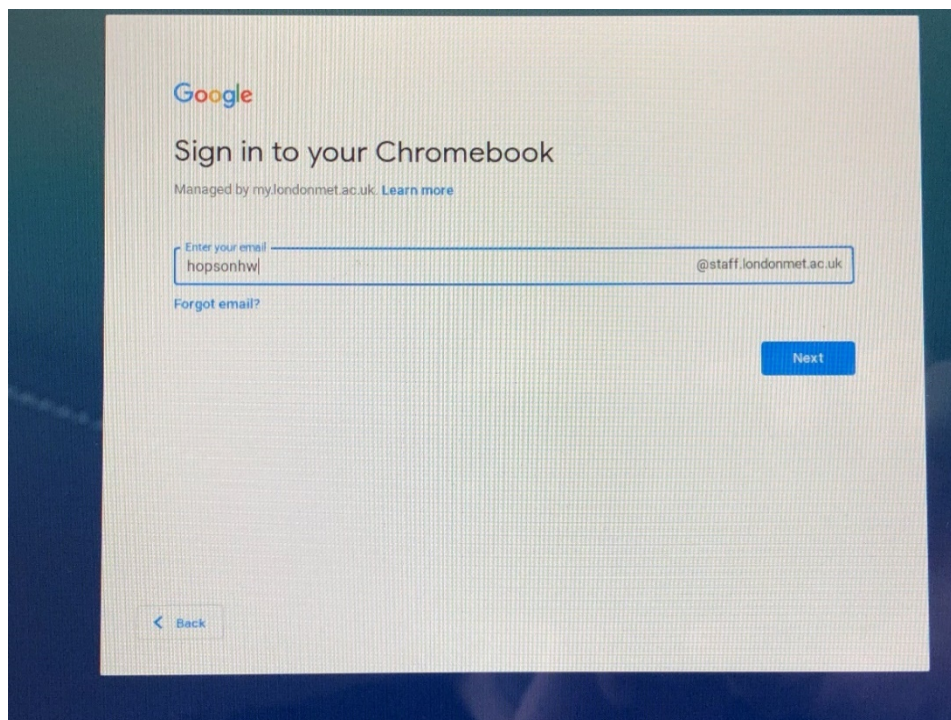


HOW TO CONNECT TO REMOTELABS USING A LONDONMET CHROMEBOOK

This guide will walk you through on how to connect and use Remotelabs using a Londonmet Chromebook.

To begin, open your Chromebook, power it on and sign into your account.



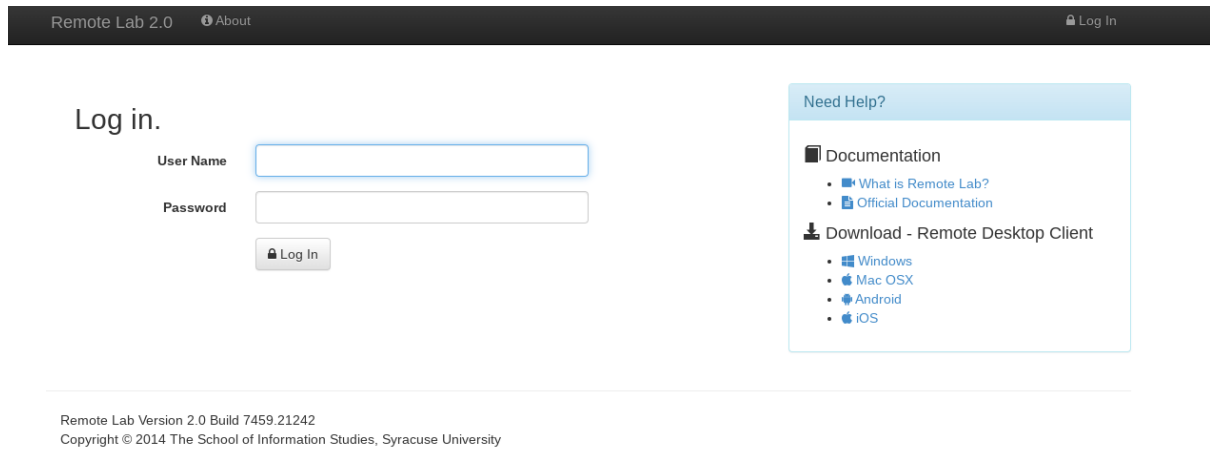
And follow the 3-step process below:

1. Install Microsoft's Remote Desktop Client application
2. Make a Reservation on Remote Lab
3. Connect to your Reservation

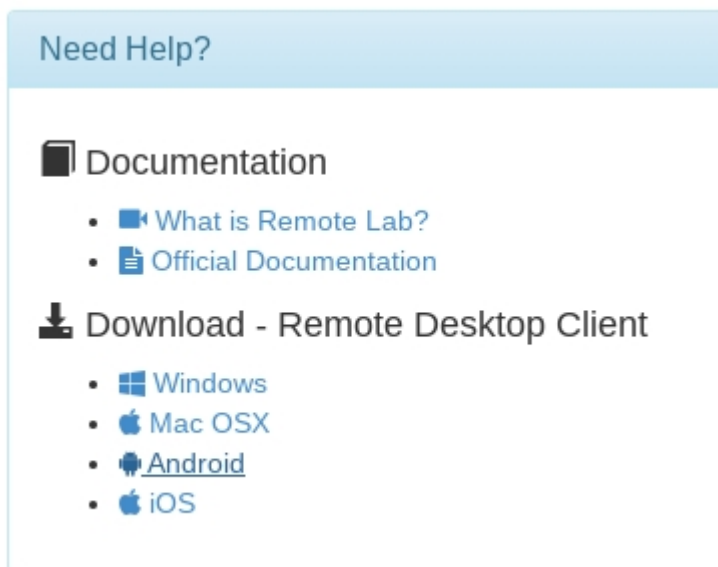
1. Install Microsoft's Remote Desktop Client application

Android:

In any browser visit [Remote Lab](#)



and click on the **Download – Remote Desktop Client** link for **Android**:



This will open the **Play Store** and invite you to **install Microsoft's Remote Desktop**:



When installation has completed, **Open the Remote Desktop client:**

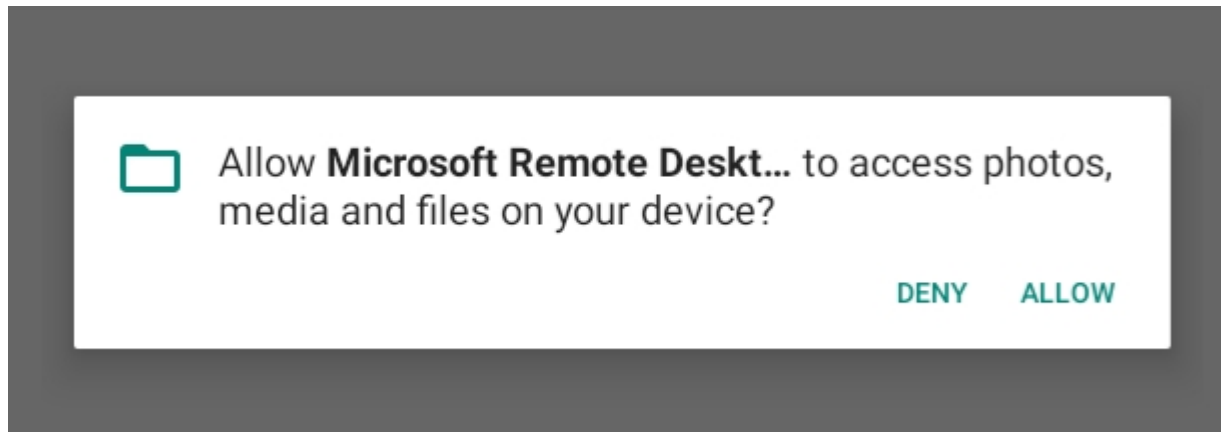

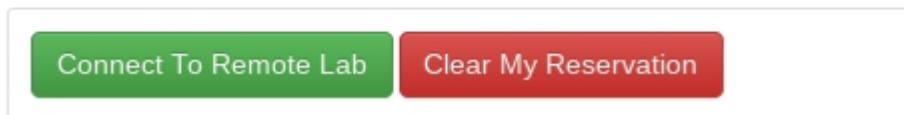
2. Make a Reservation on Remote Lab
Login to [Remote Lab](#) and **make a reservation**:



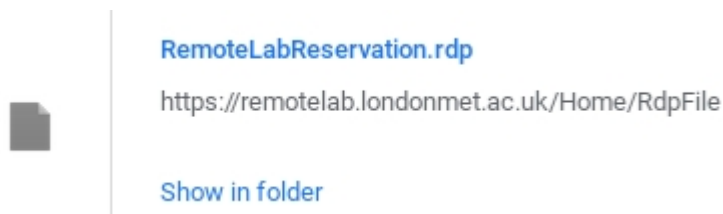
When a reservation has been made for you click on the green “**Connect to Remote Lab**” button:

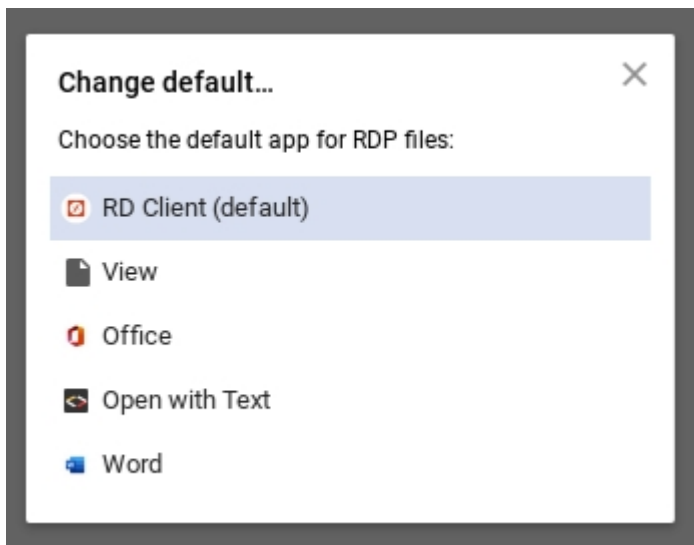
This will download a file called “**RemoteLabReservation.rdp**” which you will find in Downloads:



Click on “**Show in folder**”, highlight the RDP file you just downloaded and click the **OPEN** down arrow:

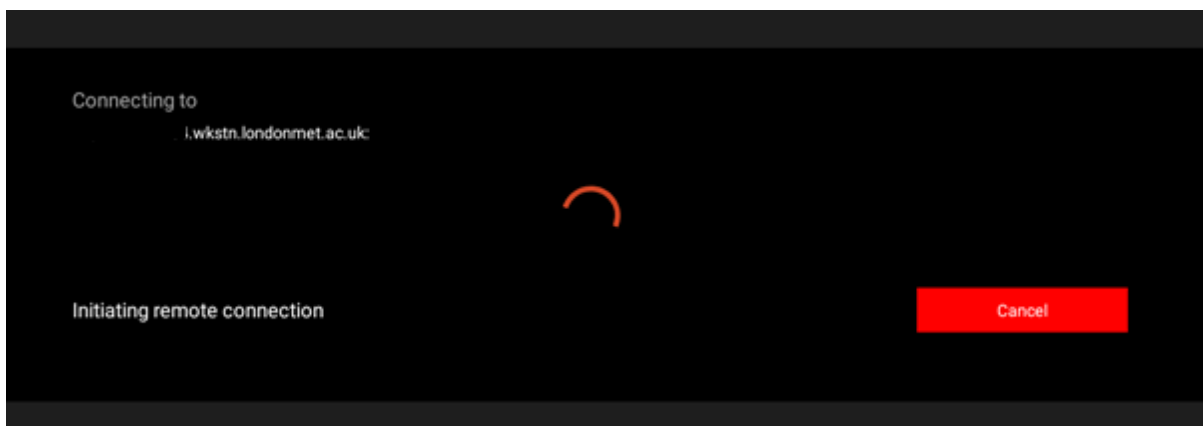

Then choose **RD Client** as the default app for **RDP files**:



3. Connect to your Reservation

Double clicking on the **RemoteLabReservation.rdp** file will start a connection to your reserved PC,



add your London Met userid (@londonmetuni.ac.uk) and password when prompted and click **CONNECT**:

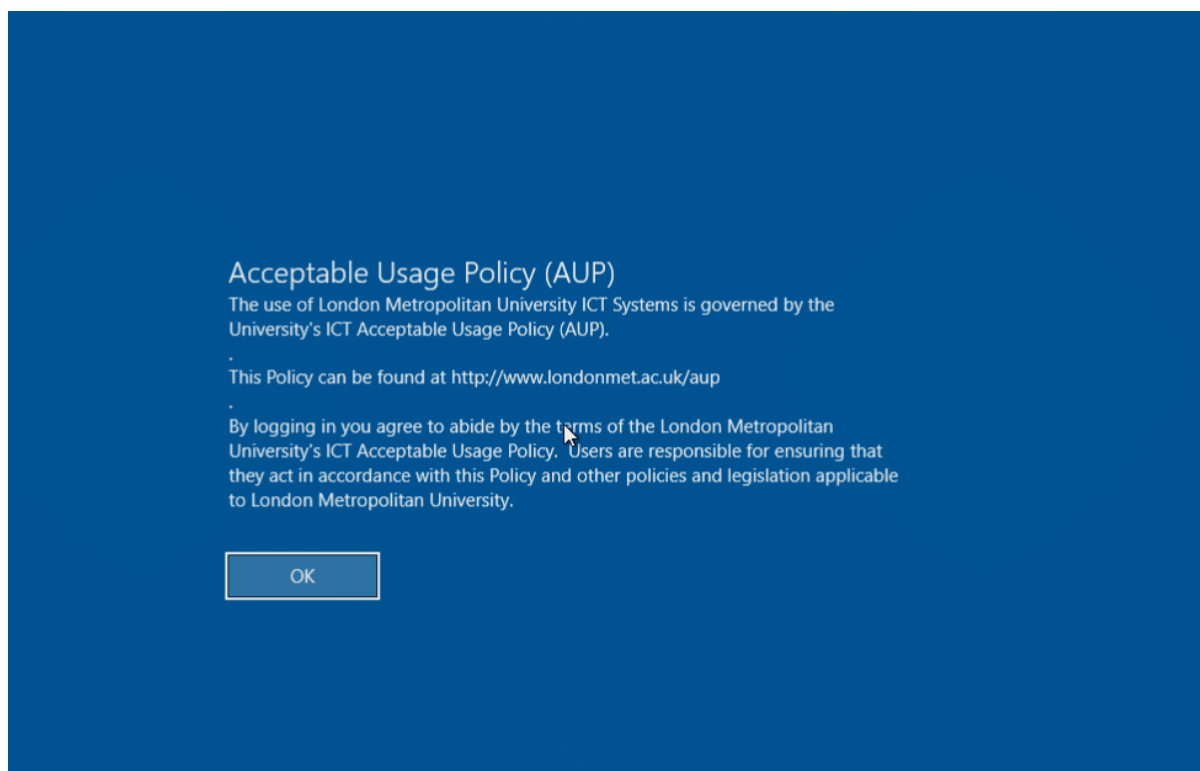
