


THE MEASURING MACHINE

- Assess which cushion will be most suitable and fit it in the measuring chair.
- Invite the person to be assessed to sit down.
- Check that the cushion is fitted in the most suitable fixing position between 1 and 6.
- Raise the seat with the power motor to the correct height, remembering the essential criteria, avoid pressure points, good lumbar and back support etc.
- Adjust the back rake for comfort.
- Choose from the rack of elements those extras to make your patient really comfortable and fit them.
- Check through the list of functions on pages 9-10 and select those required.
- Pause, check to ensure that the patient has been assessed for total comfort.






