


The Froxfield Group

The Orleans Rocker and Chair








The Highworth



The Highworth is available with or without wings, and can also be supplied with padded arms, and a removable tray.





The Compton-Group also includes the Corsham Dining Chair with arms (N17) and the Copnor Dining Chair (N18).


The Evesham Dining Table (N115) is available with a white or grey heat resistant surface.


For right is the Corpovell Chair.














The Kings and Queens Range

A group of upholstered occasional chairs with beech frames with fixed upholstery and wooden or upholstered arms. The Kings range has a head support for extra comfort, and is shown here with the Compton table.

The care of your Parker Knoll upholstery.

Regular cleaning. Dust settles everywhere and, although it isn't as noticeable on upholstery as on a table, accumulated dust on covering fabrics dulls the colours and causes deterioration. So vacuum your upholstery regularly, or clean it carefully with a soft brush.

Wet cleaning. The general cleaning of upholstery is best left to experts. We DON'T recommend wet cleaning woven fabrics with soap and detergents. If you use an upholstery shampoo, follow the instructions to the letter. Expanded vinyls and polyurethane covering materials can be washed with soap and water. Keep them clean of oils, acids, detergents and hair preparations. Do not leave close to fires or radiators.

Sharp objects. Be careful to avoid snagging the pile with sharp objects – dog and cat claws, rings, shoe buckles and heels, etc. If one of the loops breaks, don't try to pull it. It looks better if you simply cut it short.

Prolonged sunlight. Avoid exposing your upholstery to prolonged sunlight – it fades colours and shortens the life of the fabric.
